Media Advisory

(Des Moines) – The Iowa Utilities Board (IUB) will conduct a public evidentiary hearing beginning August 22, 2023, at the Cardiff Event Center, 3232 First Ave. S., Fort Dodge, Iowa, regarding the proposed Summit Carbon Solutions pipeline, [Docket No. HLP-2021-0001](#). The hearing is anticipated to last several weeks.

For media planning coverage of the hearing, there will be reserved space inside the event center for TV and still cameras to cover the daily proceedings, including witness testimony. Access is available on a first-come, first-served basis. Media will be able to access the audio system and the entire hearing will be [livestreamed](#). Reporters may sit in open seating. Wi-Fi access will also be available.

On August 22, 2023, the Cardiff Event Center will open at 9:00 a.m. and media in attendance and hearing participants will be asked to check in upon arrival to receive credentials. Anyone arriving after the hearing is underway may be asked to wait outside the hearing room until there is a break in the proceedings to avoid disruption.
