This case has been transferred to the court of appeals and has been set for oral argument **Tuesday, October 7, 2025, at 2:30 p.m.** Argument time is limited to ten minutes for each side and five minutes for reply by appellant. Multiple appellants or appellees must share the allotted time. See Iowa R. App. P. 6.908(3). Before entering the courtroom, please check in with the assistant bailiff in the court of appeals reception area.

In-state counsel must be present for oral argument when an out-of-state attorney who has been admitted pro hac vice intends to present the oral argument before this court. See Iowa Ct. Rs. 31.14(2)(a), 31.14(3).

This case has been assigned to a panel of judges to prepare for oral argument. Settlements or scheduling problems should be called to our attention immediately.

The court prefers in-person oral arguments. However, for compelling reasons, counsel may request a virtual oral argument. Compelling reasons may include health concerns, significant weather conditions, or other similar circumstances. The reason for the request shall be set forth in the motion requesting a virtual oral argument, and the motion must be filed as soon as possible after the reason is discovered. Counsel requesting such an accommodation shall first notify opposing counsel or any self-represented party of the request and advise the court of their position. Granting the motion shall be at the discretion of the Chief Judge. If the court grants the requesting party's motion, and opposing counsel or a self-represented party do not wish to appear remotely, the court will allow a hybrid argument. A hybrid argument would involve the requesting party appearing remotely and other parties conducting the oral argument in person. If the request is granted, a virtual argument may be moved to a different date and time based on scheduling needs.


