Federal Energy Regulatory Commission (FERC)

FERC is an independent U.S. government agency that operates within the Department of Energy but maintains its independence. FERC:

- Regulates Interstate Energy Transmission
- Licenses Hydropower Projects
- Approves Interstate Energy Infrastructure Projects
- Ensures Electricity Grid Reliability



Regional Transmission Organization (RTO)

- Regulated by FERC, not the IUC
- Functions
 - Manage electricity transmission across multi-state regions; this
 is considered interstate commerce under, hence the regulation
 at the federal level
 - Operate the transmission system, managing flow of electricity and maintaining reliability
 - Transmission system planning (transmission projects, impact studies)
- Two RTOs in the Iowa footprint
 - Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO)
 - Southwest Power Pool (SPP)



Midcontinent Independent System Operator (MISO)


- MISO stats
 - Area served: 15 states and Manitoba
 - Population served: 45 million
 - Transmission lines: 77,000 miles
 - Members: 56 transmission owners; 173 non-transmission owners
 - Market participants: > 550
- Committees and work groups (meetings open to public)
 - Advisory, Market, Planning Advisory, Resource Adequacy, Distributed Energy Resources, Interconnection Process, Regional Expansion Criteria & Benefits, and others
- Chair Martz is Iowa's representative on the Organization of MISO States (OMS) Board of Directors





Southwest Power Pool (SPP)

- SPP operates in 14 states and will add Wyoming, Colorado, Utah, and Arizona next year.
- In Iowa, SPP serves:
 - o 100 utilities
 - o 60,000 households
 - 9,000 businesses
 - 5,000 industrial
- In 2027, SPP will open a Day Ahead Market for the rest of the West.
- Commissioner Byrnes is the Iowa representative on the Regional State Committee (RSC).
